Your piece will be designed in an 8' wooden octagon frame on a pearlescent-painted background, the traditional shape for sailor's valentines. Registration fee includes wooden octagonal frame, specialty shells, glue and tools. Feel free to bring your favorite shell(s) to add to your project.
