July 6th - July 10th ... Grades 1st - 4th

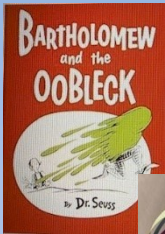
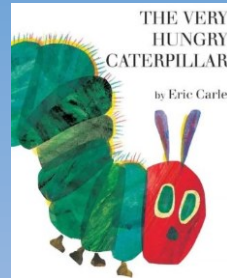

July 9 – Dr. Seuss Assemble a "Twirlygig" using rainbow colored paper, bamboo skewers and glue. While the glue dries, we will hear the story of, "Bartholomew and the Oobleck", by Dr. Seuss. A short scientific explanation of why the ingredients used to make Oobleck behave as they do will be shared.
