Create a pen and ink line drawing of your home, or any other structure incorporating the proper line weights, shading and perspective. This rendering can be used for the front of printed note cards or fine art on your home's wall.

- a kneaded eraser
- Brush-on white out
- several good quality photos or an I-pad that has a photo of the house or building you would like to use for your rendering.

You may wish to bring your own or borrow from the instructor – a small desk size drawing board, T square, and a 30-60 degree 6-8" triangle.

Bio: Richard Fanelli is a graduate of the Philadelphia College of Art. After practicing as an architect for many years, he returned to his artistic roots and has studied under nationally known landscape and portrait artists over the past 10 years.
