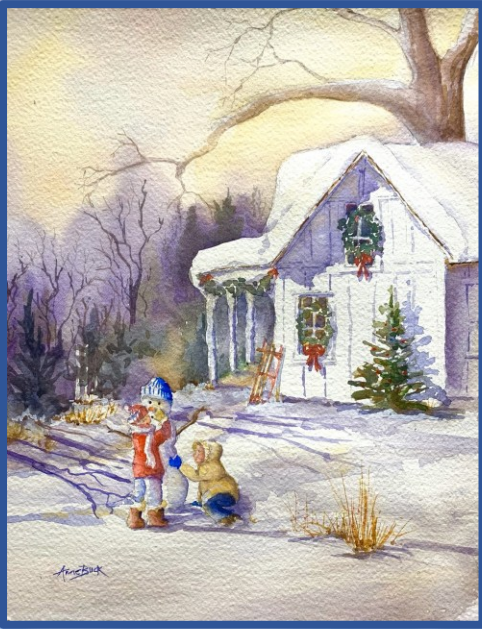




Beginner Watercolor
