Learn to make two different Granny Squares using the magic ring and circular crochet method.

Then sew them together for a warm winter hat and scarf.

Supplies About 800 yards of worsted weight yarn. You may use a solid or variegated yarn.

Caron Macchiato Cakes, sold at Michaels is a fun yarn to use.

1 size 8 (H) crochet hook

To complete the project, class will be four weeks.
