

Autumn Wire Tree Sculpture

Kathy Coyne is a self-taught artist, combining fluid acrylic techniques, print making and wire sculpture. She started working with wire to create tree sculptures to pair with monoprinted abstract landscapes and collage. Her award-winning wire sculpture “dioramas” have been exhibited across Kent and Sussex Counties in Delaware.

This class covers the basics in working with craft wire to construct a wire tree sculpture. Each student will make a wind-swept tree and embellish the base around the tree with pumpkins and other fall-inspired foliage. In this hands-on class, students will construct the tree from start to finish and will be able to take the tree home with them at the end of the class.
